DEMOGRAPHICS REPORT

Clark County is the largest county in Nevada with 2,205,207 residents, 75 percent of the state's population.

Children under the age of 5 make up approximately 6.6 percent of the population, underscoring the importance of high quality early education programs in Clark County.

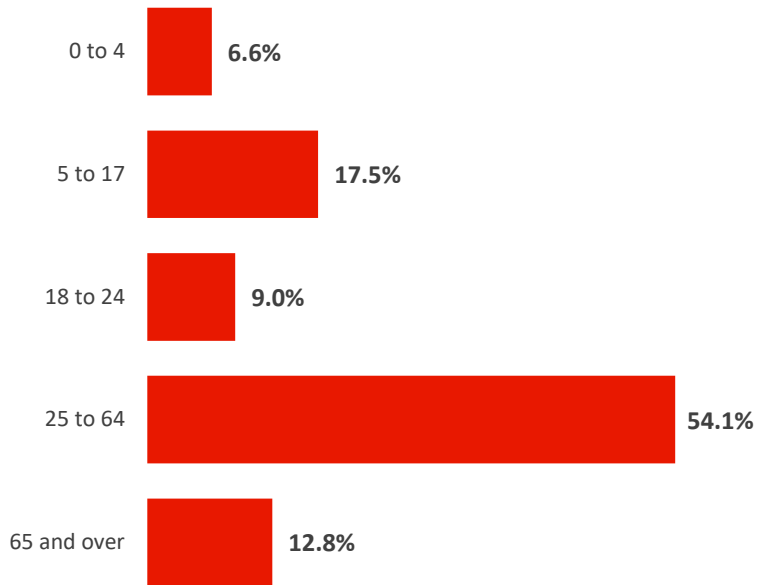
Youth populations have grown over the past 4 years, making up 17.5 percent of Clark County's population. It is important to monitor our youth to ensure they are on track to graduate.

Providing opportunities as young adults enter college and career is also important. This group is approximately 9.0 percent of the area's population.

At 63.8 percent, the Caucasian population is the largest group in Clark County, but it should be noted that Clark County's demographic profile continues to change. In 2011, the Caucasian population made up 69.3 percent of the population, and the African American population accounted for another 10.3 percent.

Clark County is also home to multiple special populations: 9.8 percent of the population are veterans and 12.0 percent of area residents have some form of disability.
