EDUCATION REPORT

Clark County is the largest county in Nevada with 2,205,207 residents, 75 percent of the state's population.

Approximately 15.5 percent of the adult population over the age of 25 has less than a HS diploma, underscoring the importance of building comprehensive and robust educational supports in Clark County.

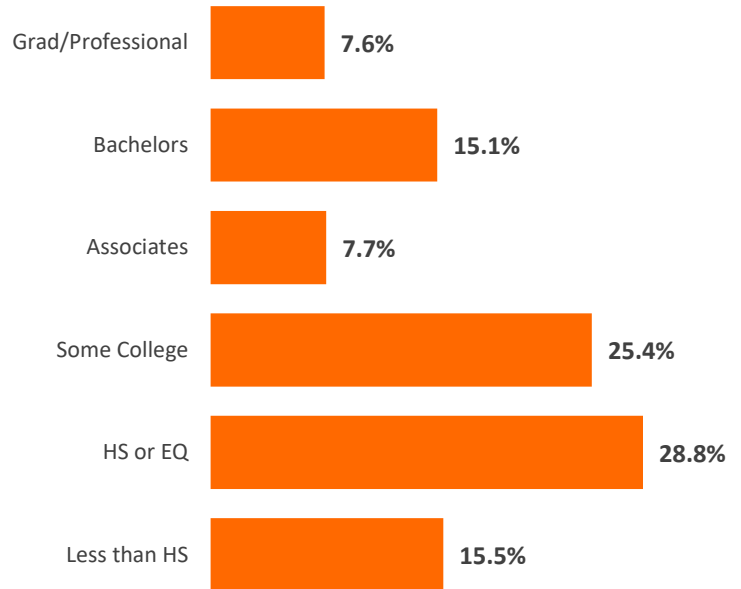
An estimated 30.3 percent of the adult population has an Associates Degree or higher. Over 63 percent of jobs now require a college degree, making higher education one of the best routes to economic success.

Clark County School District's high school graduation rate was 72.1 percent in 2015. Magnet/CTA high schools had the highest graduation rates at 97.6 percent.

Ensuring a strong educational foundation is a critical component of future success. In Clark County, 1.1 percent of the total population is enrolled in preschool.

National assessments are used to gauge student progress toward graduation. In Clark County, 47.4 percent of 4th graders are proficient in reading and 15.2 percent of 8th graders are proficient in math.

Adults over the age of 25 with a high school education make up the largest segment in Clark County
