

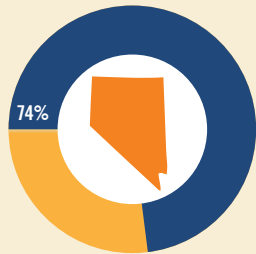


# HIGH SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT
